

THE 11^{TH} ASIAN JUNIOR WUSHU CHAMPIONSHIPS

REGULATIONS

Macau, China

August 14 – 21, 2023

1. DATE AND PLACE

The 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships will be held from August 14 to 21, 2023 in Macau China.

2. VENUES

- 2.1 Competition Venue: Tap Seac Multi-sports Pavilion (Pavilion A)
- 2.2 Training Venue: Tap Seac Multi-sports Pavilion (Pavilion B)

3. COMPETITION EVENTS

- 3.1 Taolu
 - 3.1.1 Individual Events
 - 3.1.1.1 Group A
 - The 3rd Set of International Wushu Competition Routine: Changquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu, Qiangshu; Nanquan, Nandao, Nangun; Taijiquan, Taijijian, Taijishan.
 - Duilian (Dual event).
 - 3.1.1.2 Group B
 - 1st Set of International Wushu Competition Routine: Changquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu, Qiangshu; Nanquan, Nandao, Nangun; Taijiquan (42 Forms), Taijijian (42 Forms).
 - 3.1.1.3 Group C
 - Elementary Routine: Changquan (No. 3 Elementary Routine), Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu, Qiangshu; Nanquan, Nandao, Nangun; Taijiquan (24 Forms), Taijijian (32 Forms).
 - 3.1.2 Taolu Group Events

3.2 Sanda

3.2.1 Junior Category

Male: 48KG, 52KG, 56KG, 60KG, 65KG, 70KG, 75KG, 80KG. Female: 48KG, 52KG, 56KG, 60KG.

3.2.2 Children's Category Male: 42KG, 45KG, 48KG, 52KG, 56KG.

4. QUALIFICATIONS

- 4.1 Membership
 - 4.1.1 Only those member federations/ associations have paid their WFA annual membership fees for 2022 and 2023 will be permitted to participate in the Championships.
 - 4.1.2 The federation/ association applying to join WFA may be invited to take part in the Championships after their applications have been accepted by the WFA.
- 4.2 The eligibility of the athlete
 - 4.2.1 All athletes must be citizens of the country/ region which they are representing.
 - 4.2.2 Those athletes who have dual citizenship can only represent one (1) country/ region in the championships.

5. ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Each member federation/ association is limited to enter one (1) team. Each team should be composed of one (1) Taolu team and one (1) Sanda team.

- 5.1 Taolu
 - 5.1.1 Each team shall be composed by maximum eighteen (18) members including: one(1) Team Manager, two (2) Coaches, one (1) Doctor, and fourteen (14) competitors:

Youth Group: Age 15 - 18 (the year of birth in 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008)

- Three (3) male and three (3) female competitors.
- Each competitor may enter for a maximum of five (5) competition events:
 - One (1) competition event on Changquan, Nanquan or Taijiquan.
 - One (1) competition event on Daoshu, Jianshu, Nandao or Taijijian.
 - One (1) competition event on Gunshu, Qiangshu, Nangun or Taijishan.
 - One (1) competition event on Duilian (dual event).
 - One (1) competition event on Group event.

Junior Group: Age 12 - 14 (the year of birth in 2009, 2010, 2011)

- Two (2) male and two (2) female competitors.
- Each competitor may enter for a maximum of four (4) events:
 - One (1) competition event on Changquan, Nanquan or Taijiquan.
 - One (1) competition event on Daoshu, Jianshu, Nandao or Taijijian.
 - One (1) competition event on Gunshu, Qiangshu and Nangun.
 - One (1) competition event on Group event.

Children Group: Age 8 - 12 (the year of birth in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015)

- Two (2) male and two (2) female competitors.
- Each competitor may enter for a maximum of three (3) events:
 - One (1) competition event on Changquan, Nanquan or Taijiquan.
 - One (1) competition event on Daoshu, Jianshu, Nandao or Taijijian.
 - One (1) competition event on Gunshu, Qiangshu or Nangun.
 - One (1) competition event on Group event.
- 5.1.2 Duilian (Dual event): Composed by two (2) or three (3) competitors, separate genders.
- 5.1.3 Group event: Shall be composed by six (6) and above competitors, with no restriction on the competition events and age category (it can be a combination of male and female competitors from either Youth, Junior, Children Group). It can be performed with music (no vocal accompaniment); with time limitation of 2 3 minutes.

5.2 Sanda

5.2.1 Each team shall be composed by maximum fifteen (15) members including: one (1) Team Manager, two (2) Coaches, one (1) Doctor, and eleven (11) competitors:

Junior Category: Age 15 - 17 (the year of birth in 2006, 2007, 2008)

• Five (5) male and three (3) female competitors.

Children Category: Age 12 - 14 (the year of birth in 2009, 2010, 2011)

- Three (3) male competitors.
- 5.2.2 Each team may sign-up one (1) competitor for each weight category, and each competitor is allowed to apply for only one (1) weight category.

6. COMPETITION METHOD

The Rules and Methods may be interpreted solely at the discretion of the International Wushu Federation (IWUF). In case of any disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the Chinese version shall prevail.

6.1 Taolu

- 6.1.1 Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the "IWUF Wushu Taolu Competition Rules & Judging Methods (2019)".
 - 6.1.1.1 The competition will be utilized the Non-Degree of Difficulty Scoring Method (comprising of A Group –Quality of Movements Scoring and B Group –

Overall Performance Scoring only).

- 6.1.1.2 Time limit:
 - Changquan, Daoshu, Jianshu, Gunshu, Qiangshu, Nanquan, Nandao and Nangun: no less than 1 min 10 secs.
 - Taijiquan, Taijijian and Taijishan : 3 4 minutes
 - Taijiquan (42 Forms): 5 6 minutes.
 - Taijijian (42 Forms): 4 5 minutes.
 - Duilian (Dual event): no less than 40 seconds.
 - There is no time requirement for Elementary Taolu events.

6.2 Sanda

- 6.2.1 Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the "IWUF Wushu Sanda Competition Rules & Judging Method (2017)".
- 6.2.2 If the number of competitors in a weight category is three (3) persons, a single roundrobin method will be adopted.
- 6.2.3 If only two or one athlete(s) registered in a weight category, the weight category will be cancelled.
- 6.2.4 Kicks to the head are prohibited.

7. COSTUMES & EQUIPMENTS

- 7.1 Taolu
 - 7.1.1 Costumes worn and equipment used by competitor must comply with the rules during all events.
 - 7.1.2 Competitors must prepare their own costumes and equipment.

7.2 Sanda

- 7.2.1 Competitor must wear the costumes and protective gears in compliance with the rules during the competition.
- 7.2.2 Competitor must prepare their own, competition costumes and instep guard, one (1) set in red and one (1) set in blue.
- 7.2.3 Competitor must prepare their own mouth guard and jockstrap.
- 7.2.4 The gloves and protective equipment (head guard and chest protector) will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

8. PLACING & AWARDS

8.1 Taolu

- 1st place: Gold medal and Certificate
- 2nd place: Silver medal and Certificate
- 3rd place: Bronze medal and Certificate
- 4th to 8th place: Certificate
- Awarding method:
 - 1st 8th place: If the number of competitors is above ten (10) in a single event.
 - 1st 6th place: If the number of competitors is between eight (8) to ten (10) in a single event.
 - 1st 3rd place: If the number of competitors is between five (5) to seven (7) in a single event.
 - 1st 2nd place: If the number of competitors is between three (3) to four (4) in a single event.
 - No placing or awards will be bestowed if the number of competitors in a single event comprises of two (2) or less competitors.

8.2 Sanda

- 1st place: Gold medal and Certificate
- 2nd place: Silver medal and Certificate
- 3rd place (juxtaposition): Bronze medal and Certificate

9. ENTRIES

9.1 Both preliminary entry and final entry must be submitted through the Online Registration System of Wushu Federation of Asia, all sections of the online entry must be completed in full, including the uploading of the various required documents.

9.2 Preliminary Entries

9.2.1 The deadline is 23:59 (Macau time) on June 14, 2023.

- 9.2.2 The preliminary entry forms must be sent by e-mail, post or facsimile to the "Organization Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships" and "Wushu Federation of Asia".
- 9.2.3 All teams must complete the preliminary entry before deadline in order to access the final entry system.

9.3 Final Entry

- 9.3.1 The deadline is **23:59 (Macau time) on July 14, 2023**.
- 9.3.2 The final entry forms must be signed by either the President or Secretary-General of the member federation/ association with federation/ association seal, and to be sent by e-mail, post or facsimile to the "Organization Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships" and "Wushu Federation of Asia ".
- 9.3.3 Each team is required to print a copy of the submitted entry and present it upon arrival and registration.
- 9.4 Late Registration Policy
 - 9.4.1 In case of special circumstances, late entries or changes are subject to the approval of the Wushu Federation of Asia with written document, if accepted, are subject to a late-entry fee of US\$100 per person or per change.
 - 9.4.2 The deadline for late registration is **20:00 (Macau time) on July 29, 2023**. Any application for modification of registration will not be accepted after the deadline.

10. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

- 10.1 The international airfare, related travel expenses, as well as accommodation fees of all participants (Competitors, Team Officials, Team Judges and Observers) shall be borne by the teams themselves.
 - 10.1.1 Each team shall pay the full amount of their unpaid fees to the Organizing Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships during the registration.
 - 10.1.2 The Organizing Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships will arrange the accommodation and transportation for participating teams from August 14 21, 2023. If any teams arriving earlier or departing later than the required date, they should inform the Organizing Committee to arrange their accommodation before July 14, 2023, related costs shall be borne by the team themselves.
 - 10.1.3 The Wushu Federation of Asia and the Organizing Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships request that all participating teams lodge at the designated hotels arranged. Those teams who cannot stay in the designated hotel due to special

reasons shall pay a participation fee of USD 130 per person. Those who cannot participate in the activities and competitions on time due to their own reasons shall accept responsibility for consequences arising as a result of this.

10.2 Payment method

- 10.2.1 In order to secure the accommodation, participating teams are requested to pay 50% of the total fees by international bank transfer simultaneously with the preliminary entry submission. The remaining 50% balance must be paid by international bank transfer simultaneously with the final entry submission.
- 10.2.2 Teams that are unable to pay by international bank transfer must inform both Wushu Federation of Asia and the Organizing Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships in advance and must pay the relevant fees in total upon registration.
- 10.2.3 If the participating teams do not comply with the deadline, the accommodation will not be guaranteed. The teams will be solely responsible for the consequences that may occur.

(1) The number of rooms for Observers are limited and deposit must be paid for confirmation.

(2) Please contact the Organizing Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships for special room request.

11. ARRIVAL & REGISTRATION

- 11.1 All judges are required to arrive at the designated registration booth and register with the Organizing Committee on **August 14, 2023**.
- 11.2 All participating teams are required to arrive at the designated registration booth and register with the Organizing Committee on **August 14, 2023**.
- 11.3 Upon arrival, all teams are required to:
 - Pay the relevant participation fees in full.
 - Submit all required documents.

12. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT AND TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

- 12.1 The Organizing Committee of the 11th Asian Junior Wushu Championships shall be responsible for organizing the championships under the guidance of the Executive Committee and Technical Committee of Wushu Federation of Asia.
- 12.2 Each team may appoint one (1) Taolu and one (1) Sanda Team Judge. The Team Judges must hold their valid certificates of the International Grade Judge issued by IWUF.
- 12.3 Technical Delegate, Jury of Appeals, and appointed judges will be sent by the WFA.

13. TECHNICAL MEETING

- 13.1 The Technical Meeting will take place at 09:00 (Macau time) on August 16, 2023. Matters of the competition will be discussed during the meeting.
- 13.2 Each team may respectively send two (2) representatives for Taolu and Sanda to attend this meeting.

14. DRAW-LOTS CEREMONY

- 14.1 The draw-lots ceremony will take place at 10:00 (Macau time) on August 16, 2023.
- 14.2 Each team may respectively send two (2) representatives for Taolu and Sanda. The representative of the Jury of Appeal will draw on behalf of the teams that are unable to send a representative to attend.

15. WEIGHT-IN

- 15.1 The first weigh-in will be held at 07:00 (Macau time) on August 16, 2023, location is to be determined.
- 15.2 Athletes must submit their accreditation and passport for inspection at each weigh-in session, both are indispensable.
- 15.3 Those athletes participating in the daily competing are required to weigh-in at the designated time and place prior to the start the day's events. The time and place are to be determined.
- 15.4 Competitors will be disqualified if their weighing results do not meet the requirements of their reported weight class.

16. VICTORY CEREMONY

- 16.1 The medalists are required to attend the Victory Ceremony.
- 16.2 The medalists must report to the designated place fifteen (15) minutes before the Victory Ceremony starts, and must wear their team official uniforms.
- 16.3 The medalists are not allowed to wear one-piece suits, gloves, hats, goggles, sunglasses, etc. to attend the award ceremony, and are not allowed to take any religious symbols to or onto the podium.
- 16.4 The medalists who are absent from the Victory ceremony without a valid reason will forfeit the right to receive a medal.
- 16.5 The award-winning athletes who violate the provisions of 16.2 and 16.3 will be disqualified from receiving medals.
- 16.6 If fewer than three (3) medalists in a single event, no Victory Ceremony will be held for that event. The team leader will go to the designated place to receive medal and certificate.

17. OTHER MATTERS

17.1 Each team must strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the competition and compete fairly.

- 17.2 Those who violate the regulations will be dealt with severely in accordance with the relevant regulations of the Wushu Federation of Asia.
- 17.3 Each team must bring and submit the following items and information when reporting:
 - 17.3.1 Three pieces of national flag, regional flag or association flag (1m x 2m).
 - 17.3.2 U disk with the national anthem or association anthem recorded in MP3 format.
 - 17.3.3 Athlete's medical certificate.
 - 17.3.4 Athlete's personal insurance certificate.
 - 17.3.5 Signed Waiver of Liabilities forms from the participating team members.
 - 17.3.6 One copy of final entry form.
